RWY 13L/31R and TWYs status incorrect

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2407, effective 11 July 2024, contain incorrect data for Zayed Intl; Abu Dhabi, UAE (OMAA). UAE AIP SUP 31/2024, effective 11 July 2024, introduced "RWY 13L/31R closure for rehabilitation and maintenance" was received after 2407 AIRAC cycle data processing due date, therefore following Phase 1 changes, effective 29 June 2024, are not reflected in cycle 2407 data:

- RWY 13L/31R is closed
- TWYs A1, A2, A3, A5, A6, A8, A10, A11, A13, A16, A17 and A18 are closed
- TWY Z3 is closed
- TWY A (excluding intersection with TWY A14) is closed
- TWY B (between TWY A1 and K1, excluding intersection with TWY K1) is closed
- TWY B (between TWY A14 and A18, excluding intersection with TWY A14) is closed
- TWYs B4, B7, B9 and B15 are closed
- TWY G (between TWY A and B, excluding intersection with TWY B) is closed
- TWY H (between TWY A and B, excluding intersection with TWY B) is closed
- Low Visibility Procedures for RWY 31L are updated
