Hot Spots 1-3 incorrect

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2310, effective 05 October 2023, contains incorrect data for Narita Intl; Tokyo, Japan (RJAA). AMDT 14/2023, effective 05 October 2023, published 05 October 2023 introduced the following changes, which are not reflected in cycle 2310 data:

- Added Hot Spot 1, located at Holding point B8:
 Pilots taxiing to holding point B8 are to make a slight left turn to join the centerline correctly.
- Added Hot Spot 2, located at complex intersection area with a convergence of numerous TWYs
 (K, C, E2, E3, P) and E3GWY:
 Numerous cases of entering the wrong TWY occur in this area. In particular, entering K by mistake will cause "head-on" traffic with aircraft vacating from RWY16L.
 Pilots taxiing to RWY16L via C must not make a right turn at E2 without ATC authorization.
- Added Hot Spot 3, located at complex intersection area with a convergence of numerous TWYs
 (K, C, S7, S6) and S7GWY/S6GWY:
 Pilots taxiing via S7 or S6 should pay extra attention to signs and markings to avoid misunderstanding of TWYs.
