

## **Guidance for International Shipments to UA**

## A 'Best Practices' Guide to Streamline Shipments through U.S. Customs

International shipments have become increasingly complex over the past decade. To assist our customers and partners through the product return process, we have developed this <u>'Best Practices'</u> guide.

## **Preparing Your Shipment**

In order to streamline shipments through U.S. Customs and to our facility, please:

- 1. Ensure your shipping carrier is notified that there is a Customs Broker involved in the shipment.
- 2. Choose the **Broker Select option** in your carrier's online processing system or airway bill. *Note: when using FedEx, use the long-form airway bill with the IPBSO option.*
- 3. Enter UA's Customs Broker information:

- Your Export Documentation needs to be accurate and complete to ensure timely import clearance.
- 6. A "Foreign Shipper's Declaration" should be completed and provided to UA as part of your Export Documentation. This form is available online.
- 7. In addition to the above, your commercial invoice *must include* the following information (see also, page :
  - Incoterms (typically "FCA, Supplier's Facility Tucson"),
  - Country of Origin/Manufacture<sup>1</sup> (USA for UA's parts),
  - Consignee/Importer of Record (typically UA),
  - Value (in USD).
- 8. Process the shipment.
- 9. Email UA the shipment information *in advance* to <u>tammy.holderread@universalavionics.com</u>, <u>repairs@universalavionics.com</u>, and to <u>john.lopez@universalavionics.com</u>, and include the following information:
  - (1) Shipment documentation (commercial invoice must be in English),
  - (2) Tracking number,
  - (3) Part numbers and serial numbers for the items that will be shipped to UA.

UA will review your shipment to ensure all pertinent information is included and ensure the 3311 CBP Form and Manufacturer's Affidavit Form are completed for DSV Air & Sea.
